Code of Conduct

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Only One You (OOY) Workshops are intended to help pre-tween/tween boys and girls develop their already present potential through skill building exercises. Workshops have been designed to provide each child with tools that will help build stronger foundations so that they feel better equipped to manage the life challenges. Each workshop provides developmentally appropriate opportunities for young girls and boys to experience life skills, to practice them, and be able to use them as necessary throughout her lifetime. As such, it is important each workshop participant adhere to proper procedures to ensure the safety of all involved. Please review the following Code of Conduct with your child prior to attending the workshop.

Respect

- Ⓢ Listen to staff members as they are there for your safety and to provide everyone with an excellent workshop experience.
- Ⓢ Respect the property and equipment you will be using.
- Ⓢ Respect every person's right to have a positive experience.
- Ⓢ Use good manners and not bad language; be accepting of differences and considerate of the feelings of others; don't threaten, hurt, or harm anyone; deal peacefully with anger, insults, or disagreements.
- Ⓢ If you need assistance, ask a staff member.

Responsibility

- Ⓢ You are responsible for everything you bring with you to the workshop.
- Ⓢ You are responsible for carrying your own things
- Ⓢ You are responsible for your own actions.
- Ⓢ Take home everything you bring to the workshop including any and all lunch garbage. Please bring a Litterless Lunch (Not applicable to pre-tween workshop participants).

Safety

- Ⓢ Please stay within the parameters of the building at all times.
- Ⓢ Listen to the instruction of the workshop facilitators.

Zero Tolerance

- Ⓢ OOO Workshops has a Zero Tolerance Policy with regards to physical violence and bullying. Ignoring this policy will result in any workshop participant's immediate dismissal.
